May Day Fun Day: 5 June 2022

The fun days held in conjunction with Devoted 2 Dachshunds Rescue are always well supported and lots of fun. The aim of these events is to encourage participation in events by pet owners who may not be interested in showing their dachshunds but are nevertheless keen to be involved in social activities that include their dogs. The off leash play area is always a great place to meet new dachshund owners and for dogs to run around and play together. The Fancy Dress is always well supported, as is the group walk, Musical Mats and the Dachie Dash. This year there was a Maypole dance plus a face painter on hand to paint the childrens faces (and any adults that wished to participate).







Lots of stall holders attended selling all sorts of dachshund related goods, plus the food stalls did a roaring trade in snacks and refreshments. Overall, the sum of \$2787 was raised for the Devoted 2 Dachshunds Rescue group who use all of these funds to assist with vet bills which are exorbitant. Their total vet bills for the financial year ending 30 June 2022 are approximately \$140,000, so every little bit that can be raised helps to pay for rescued and adopted dachshunds, many of whom need surgery for IVDD or Pes Varus as their owners cannot afford the surgery and so relinquish the dogs to the care of the rescue group. Another fun event is planned for September this year with details to be provided nearer the time.

This bitch then went on to win the cc in the Mini Smooth bitch line-up, a great feat for a veteran! Runner Up to Best in Show was the SSH bitch, Nicholyev The Golden Snitch, owned by John Bower and Shelly Kelly and handled by Talia Kelly, making it a very successful day for the Kellys and well worth their trip up from Newcastle. 


Congratulations to Rachel Daly
